know:**

○ 1 point, on 1 test, on 1 day can cause a child to be held back in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade; parents have no legal recourse.

○ For the first time, our youngest children will be subjected to standardized tests in Art, Music and Physical Education, solely for the purpose of ranking teachers.

○ More High-Stakes tests and test preparation materials cause financial stress for school districts on top of deep cuts in state funding.
