THE TAWLS GOLDEN APPLE AWARD

Golden Apple Award is an annual award given by TAWLS to recognize the service, dedication, and support the individual has shown for teachers in the district.

I. PURPOSE:

This award may be given to a volunteer or non-TAWLS staff member of WLS.

II. THE AWARD:

This award shall be a plaque with the award name, school name, date, and recipient's name inscribed.

III. ELIGIBILTY:

- 1. The recipient can be a school staff member, or volunteer, not affiliated with T.A.W.L.S.
- 2. The recipient has had consistent long term involvement, not just an occasional volunteer.
- 3. The recipient "goes beyond" normal volunteering or helping out.
- 4. The recipient makes a positive difference to the staff and /or students.

CONSIDERATIONS:

TAWLS will provide the award and can be given at the yearly banquet, however it is expected that the award be presented to the recipient at a mutual agreed time and location to properly celebrate the winner's dedication to the work of TAWLS. The presenting school and nominating teacher will make arrangements for its presentation. The award can be presented prior to the end of the school year, based on the presenter & winner schedule. Limit 1-3 awards per school/per year

Each nomination must be written/typed separately, unless it is a joint award. Typed nominations need to be printed off and sent to Awards Committee Chair, Heather Densmore @ Whitmer by April 30th, unless the presentation of the award is time sensitive, then special consideration will be given and arrangements will be made by contacting the Awards Committee Chair.
